- Plan and facilitate age appropriate programming for children in the Elmwood Community.
- Provide support and assistance with community events and group outings.
- Adhere to all cleaning/safety protocols provided.

- Experience in planning and facilitating programs for children and youth an asset.
- Child Abuse Registry Check and Criminal Record Check required.
- Training in First Aid and CPR an asset.
