JOB TITLE: Riverwood Kids Summer Program Leader

JOB OVERVEW:

Students will be responsible for assisting with the planning, leading, and implementing programs and experiences for elementary aged children in a group setting under the direction of the Director and Assistant Director. They will serve as Day Camp support/leaders, creating video resources for families, running drop-in day programs for kids, as well as general assistants to the Riverwood Kids ministry as needed.

TIME REQUIREMENTS:

General office hours are 9:00a.m. to 5:00p.m. Tuesday to Friday. Alternative working hours (evening + weekends) may be required periodically to meet the requirements of the position.

RESPONSBILITIES:

- Ensure safety and care of children in programming.
- Plan and facilitate day camp and event programming.
- Adhere to all cleaning/safety protocols provided.
